Festival Itinerary

SATURDAY-SUNDAY, JUNE 29-30, 2019 - DEPARTURE USA

Flight from North America to Sydney, Australia.




MONDAY, JULY 1, 2019 - SYDNEY

Upon arrival, visit "The Rocks," Sydney's oldest colonial district on the foreshore of Sydney Harbor. Overnight Sydney.

TUESDAY, JULY 2, 2019 - SYDNEY


Sightseeing tour of Sydney Harbor by ferry visiting Manly on the northern side for lunch. Afternoon Performance at Darling Harbor, one of the largest tourist areas in the city. Optional performance at the Sydney Opera House. Overnight Sydney.

WEDNESDAY, JULY 3, 2019 - SYDNEY / HOBART, TASMANIA



Morning workshop with Brett Waymark, conductor of the Sydney Philharmonia choir or similar. Afterwards, transfer to Sydney's domestic airport for the short flight across the Bass Strait to Tasmania. Overnight Hobart, Tasmania.

THURSDAY, JULY 4, 2019 - HOBART




Walk from the hotel to the first rehearsal for the main massed choir performance (St. Matthew Passion in 2016). Afternoon visit to Hobart's iconic Salamanca Markets including an open air public performance in Salamanca Markets. In the evening enjoy an open air concert with one of the international acapella acts. Overnight Hobart.

FRIDAY, JULY 5, 2019 - HOBART

Second rehearsal followed by an afternoon visit to the Bonorong Wildlife Sanctuary. In the evening attend performances by participating festival ensembles. Overnight Hobart.

SATURDAY, JULY 6, 2019 - HOBART



Drive to Port Arthur to visit Australia's first penal colony. Return to Hobart for the dress rehearsal and Evening Massed Choir Concert Performance in Hobart. Overnight Hobart.


SUNDAY, JULY 7, 2019 - HOBART

Catch the ferry across the Derwent River to MONA, one of the finest modern art museums in the world. Perform in the main hall of MONA - you can even do an impromptu on the ferry! Return to Hobart and attend evening festival concerts. Overnight Hobart.

MONDAY, JULY 8, 2019 - LAUNCESTON

Early start for the bus trip to the northern city of Launceston. Afternoon tour of Launceston followed by an Evening Concert Performance. Overnight in Launceston.

TUESDAY, JULY 9, 2019 - HOBART



Drive back to Hobart this morning enjoying the breathtaking natural scenery along the way. After an early Farewell Dinner, join the thousands of other singers for the "Festival of Voices" songs around the bonfire. After the bonfire you may wish to enjoy one last performance from the festival. Overnight Hobart.

WEDNESDAY, JULY 10, 2019 - HOBART

Morning flight from Hobart to Sydney with a day at leisure. Overnight Sydney.

THURSDAY, JULY 11, 2019 - DEPARTURE SYDNEY

Transfer to Sydney's International Airport for your return flight to North America (arrival on the same day.)
