Past Custom Performance Tours



Costa Rica: San Jose, Jaco, and Quepos. Formal evening concert in San Jose, outreach concert in a San Jose community center, and informal singing at the Church of the Agony. Sightseeing highlights include the National Theater of Costa Rica, the Doka Coffee Estate, La Paz Waterfall Gardens, the Manuel Antonio National Park. Tours also available to the Arenal Volcano area with the cloud forests of Monteverde and Santa Elena and the northern lowlands of the country, hot springs of La Fortuna and Tamarindo one of the most beautiful beaches on the Nicoya Peninsula and one of the Costa Rica's best known surf spots.

Los Angeles area: Perform at Santa Monica Pier as part of the Pier JAM Series, performance at Universal Studios Hollywood, church concert on Catalina Island, short performance at the LA Skyspace Observatory, and a clinic and shared concert with a top high school choral program in the area. Sightseeing highlights include the La Brea Tar Pits, the TMZ Tour Center, Universal Studios, Hollywood Walk of Fame, the TLC Chinese Theatre, Rodeo Drive, Beverly Hills, the Walt Disney Concert Hall, a cruise to and activities on Catalina Island, and a visit to Disneyland.

Nashville: Clinic with a prominent local choral conductor, an Inside Tracks recording session at the Country Music Hall of Fame Museum, outdoor performance at the Opry House, and a shared concert with a high school choir at the chapel of a local university. Sightseeing highlights include a Driving City Tour of Nashville incl. the Parthenon, Music Row, RCA Studio B, and Fort Nashboro, visits to Belle Meade Plantation, the Ryman Auditorium, and the Hermitage, a backstage tour of the Opry House, and tickets to performances at the Grand Ole Opry and the BB King's Blues Club.

New Orleans: Performance at a Veterans Center, concert at St. Louis Cathedral, and outdoor concert at the Founders Plaza of the National WWII Museum. Sightseeing highlights include the Oak Alley Plantation, a Ghosts & Spirits Walking Tour of New Orleans, the National WWII Museum, a mask-making workshop at Mardi Gras World, a visit to Preservation Hall, a Swamp & Bayou tour, the New Orleans' French Market, and a dinner cruise on the Natchez Paddle Wheel Steamer.

New Zealand: Auckland, Omapere, Paihia, Hamilton, Rotorua, and Queenstown. Exchange concert and dinner with a local Northland High School as well as with a private diocesan high school in Hamilton. Two choral workshops with highly regarded local clinicians, Māori Instrumental Workshop in Rotorua. Sightseeing highlights include the Tasmanian Sea, encounters with Te Matua Ngahere, Father of the Forest, and Tane Mahuta, Lord of the Forest, Hururu Falls, Hamilton Gardens, Hobbiton Excursion, Waitomo Glowworm Caves, Skylight Queenstown, and much more.

Northern Ireland and Republic of Ireland: Belfast, Derry, Sligo, Galway, and Dublin. Sing morning church service as well as Evensong in Belfast, collaborative concert with a local community choir in Derry, formal evening concerts in Galway and Dublin, workshop with a famous Irish choral composer. Sightseeing highlights include the Hill of Tara, the Titanic Experience and the murals at Shankill and Falls Road in Belfast, the Giant's Causeway, the Michael Coleman Traditional Music Center in Sligo, Kylemore Abbey and Connemara, Trinity College and the Book of Kells in Dublin, and much more.

Seattle: Spend a full day at a prominent School of Music and take part in multiple clinics with renowned university music educators and conductors and attend rehearsals by various university choral ensembles, perform an exchange concert with a local high school



music program. Sightseeing highlights include Bill Speidel's Underground Tour of Seattle, tickets to a Mariners baseball game, visits to the Space Needle, Pike's Place Market and the Museum of Flight, Ride the Ducks of Seattle, and attend a performance of the Seattle Symphony.

South Korea, Vietnam, and the Philippines: Seoul, Hanoi, Hai Phong City, Manila, and Batangas. Choral workshop and collaborative performance at a Seoul university, formal evening concert together with a local professional choir in Seoul, concert at the National University of Art Education in Hanoi, concert at a local music school in Hai Phong City, formal evening concerts in Manila and Batangas. Sightseeing highlights include Gyeongbok Palace, outdoor activities in the Bukaksan mountains, the Namdaemun Market in Seoul, Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum, the Presidential Palace and Ho's house in Hanoi, a cyclo tour of Hanoi, an overnight cruise on Ha Long Bay, a visit with a local Vietnamese family, Taal Lake and beach time in Batangas, and much more.

Sweden, the Baltic States, and Finland: Stockholm, Riga, Tartu, Tallinn, and Helsinki. Gala concert in Stockholm, formal concert in Riga, sing during worship service in Tartu, evening concert Tallinn, workshop with a prominent Baltic composer, evening concert at the Church of the Rock in Helsinki. Sightseeing highlights include Stockholm City Hall where the Nobel Prize banquet is held, the Riga and Tallinn Song Festival Grounds, Gauja National Park, Tartu University and Gardens, the Orthodox Cathedral of Tallinn, the Sibelius Monument and a scenic cruise in Helsinki, and much more.

Argentina, Chile, and Peru: Buenos Aires, Córdoba, La Plata, Mendoza, Santiago de Chile, Lima, and Cusco. Collaborative concerts throughout Latin America in major venues such as Teatro Colón, Catedral de La Plata, Aula Magna de la Universidad de Santiago de Chile and more. Joint choir and orchestra performances in Córdoba and San Juan. Mass participation and solo concerts with strong local support throughout Peru.
